Tentative Trip Date

On this statement you will notice that a "Tentative Date" is listed for your group. This tentative date is based on the graduation date that has been submitted, so please let our office know if your graduation date is incorrect. In an effort to maximize our blocks of airline seats and ensure that everyone in a particular group travels together, the confirmed departure dates are issued 30 days prior to departure. This tentative date is subject to change and may do so until 30 days prior to your departure. Until you receive your confirmed travel dates from our office, please be sure not to plan events or purchases that cannot be moved to match your confirmed travel dates. The tentative date should only be used as a guide, and inflexible plans should not be made according to a TENTATIVE date.

Verify Your Information!

With each statement, you should verify your personal information and call our office with any changes. Make sure we have your LEGAL name registered and that this name matches the identification (Passport/License) you'll be presenting at the airport. Also check that we have your correct birth date, country of citizenship, and your PASSPORT number. We must have your passport number prior to your departure.



TRAVEL TIPS

Due to the increase in domestic and international taxes, your invoice reflects a slight increase in the destination's departure taxes. This increase is shown on your enclosed invoice. Travel Tips will be mailed to each traveler with their final documents approximately 2 weeks prior to departure. Included in this mailer will be hotel phone numbers and airline specific information for your travel needs. If your airline will charge any additional fees for baggage, those guidelines will be included.

PASSPORT NEEDED FOR MEXICO & BAHAMAS!!!

Grad Week is not responsible for any traveler that is denied boarding for not having the proper documentation to travel!! If you are traveling to Mexico or the Bahamas you will need to have a valid passport to travel. It is not too early to apply for a passport.
