Please enter your passport number and expiration date into your account online. If you are traveling to Hawaii, you will need a valid government issued picture id (driver's license, id card).

Reminder...your next minimum payment of at least \$50 is due by January 5, 2009. The final balance is due in our office by March 1, 2009.

Who will I room with?

After the March 1, 2009 final payment deadline, we will mail out a rooming worksheet and instructions. You will fill in who you would like to room with and mail or fax it back to our office by April 6, 2009. Please keep in mind that our prices are based on 4 to a room and there are additional occupancy fees for anyone that does not have 4 in their room. Parents that are traveling and designated as "parents" or "adults" on their accounts will have the option of choosing to have 2 to a room at 1/2 of the normal double occupancy rate. Occupancy fees are listed on your invoice.
